Short description of the Action

Aim: Mainly aims to the public awareness raising on FLIRE project's objectives and results. At the same time the official FLIRE's website will support the early warning systems and the DSS platform. Additional communication elements such as newsletters, short documentary and tutorials will be used for maximization of project's impact to general public and special target groups (authorities, stakeholders, etc.)

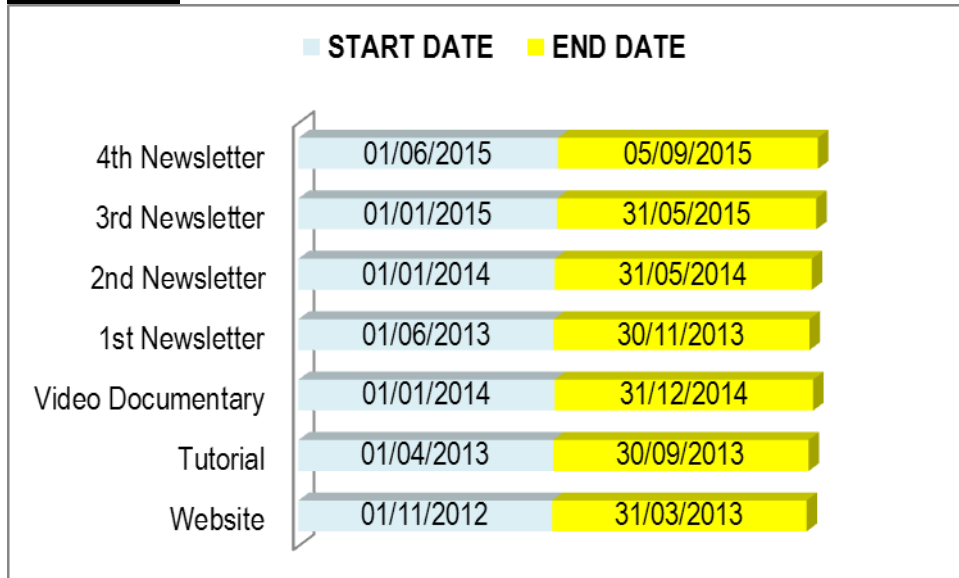
