Short description of the Action

Aim:

This action mainly aims to awareness raising and involvement of local society from study area in the project. Activities under on-site dissemination will force the public consultation and active participation in order to achieve the engagement of key stakeholders in FLIRE's implementation.

Objectives:

On-site dissemination will focus on workshops and meetings with municipality and regional environmental authorities, local society, NGOs, media and citizens in order to inform, sensitize and educate them in floods and fires interaction and efficient management of these hazards.

Furthermore connection with local society will provide useful feedback and information regarding the area status and will support the monitoring of the project's impact on local society (Action C.1.).

Meetings will target to representatives and key persons from stakeholders and authorities, while workshops will be open to local societies and citizens. Notice boards will be established in key points of the study area to further communicate FLIRE and its objectives.

Expected outcomes:

- 16 round table meetings with key representatives from stakeholders
- 4 events (workshops)
- 2 Notice boards

Main constraint of this action is active participation and engagement of local society and stakeholders, although most of them are already informed on the project since proposal stage and have shown a significant interest since the area suffers from fires and floods events the last years with serious socioeconomic and environmental effects.

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Tasks :

- 16 targeted meetings: during FLIRE life cycle. **High Priority**
- 1st workshop: at the beginning of the project. **High Priority**
- 2nd workshop: during the development of the DSS platform and the end of Action B.3 (aiming to get feedback for the visualization of the flood maps). **High Priority**
- 3rd workshop: during the development of the DSS tool and prior to its full implementation. **High Priority**
- 4th workshop: after the application of the DSS tool and close to the completion of the project. **High Priority**
- 2 Notice boards will be established in the study area, after the 1st semester of the project life. **High Priority**

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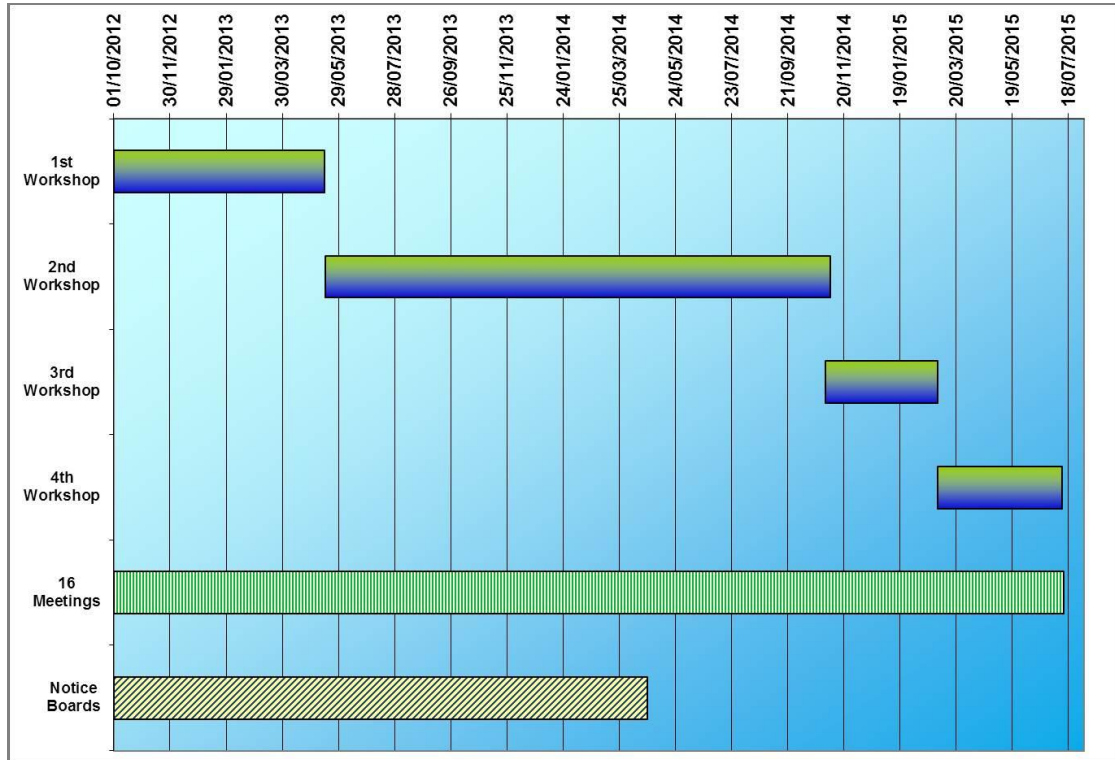
